

Tricounty Link services will run as regularly scheduled on August 21, 2017

Here is what to expect day of the event:

- Anticipate delays during and after the eclipse which will take place between 1:15pm-4:08pm. The total eclipse will take place at 2:44pm until 2:47pm.
- For safety reasons all Tricounty Link services will hold in place starting at 2:39pm and will remain on hold until around 2:52pm. This means your bus will stop at a designated safe location along your route for about 10 minutes.
- Drivers will provide eclipse glasses to passengers on board the bus at the time of the event to view the eclipse. Passengers will be allowed to deboard the bus to view the event (passengers are not required to get off the bus). <u>Please remain close to the vehicle and do not stand in any</u> <u>driveways or roadways.</u>
- Passengers will need to re-board the bus around 2:50pm and quickly be seated so the bus can prepare to resume service.
- Most routes will be slightly off schedule following the main portion of the eclipse, but staff will try to get back on regular schedule as soon as possible.
- The full event will end at 4:08pm. We anticipate delays throughout the system as regular rush hour traffic combines with people leaving observation sites throughout the Charleston/Moncks Corner area.
