Supervises and coordinates the activities of the general automotive mechanic engaged in repair and servicing of vehicles. Trains and assists the general automotive mechanic in repairing and maintaining vehicles. Inspects, diagnoses, and repairs a variety of gasoline-powered automotive equipment, including automobiles, trucks and heavy equipment. Performs major maintenance jobs, such as transmission or engine overhauls. Repairs, rebuilds, or replaces defective, worn, or broken parts. Keeps inventory of repair parts and equipment and orders replacement stock parts. Keeps maintenance records of repair reports on all vehicles. Road tests repaired CDL & non-CDL vehicles & inspects said vehicles for quality of workmanship. Rotates work schedule with general automotive mechanic during scheduled or unscheduled time-off to ensure vehicle coverage. Repairs or replaces damaged body parts. Performs other related duties, as assigned. Perform all duties in a safe and effective manner in accordance with OSHA guidelines and general shop safe practices.

QUALIFICATIONS: High school education, plus additional post high school training, pertaining to general automotive or diesel mechanics desired. Four or more years' experience (gasoline or diesel) in order to produce work of acceptable quality and sufficient quantity under direct or indirect supervision. Knowledge through extensive training and experience that enables him/her to operate, inspect, diagnose problems, repair, or install complex vehicles or equipment; additionally, must exercise a significant degree of independent judgment with leadership ability; finally, must perform a variety of independent operations. Must possess a CDL A or B license, with passenger endorsement. Maintain regular and dependable attendance.
