


DRAFT CONCEPTS FOR MAYBANK HIGHWAY ON-DEMAND (LONG-TERM)

TriCounty Link (TCL) is exploring a range of ideas to improve mobility across Berkeley, Charleston, and Dorchester Counties. The ideas described here are **concepts for discussion—not recommendations**. We're asking for community feedback to help us understand what matters most before any decisions are made. We are seeking your feedback on how services could change both in the near future (within 3 years) and in the long term (within 10 years).

New Long-term (by 2035) service concept: On-Demand



Potential long-term schedule for this concept:

This new on-demand service would serve multiple neighborhoods along Maybank Highway on Johns
Island between Fenwick Crossroads and Stono River in the east. Service would be available all
week and have operating hours similar to fixed-route service. Riders would be able to travel anywhere
within the zone and connect to weekday hourly fixed-route service (C204) to James Island and CARTA.
